

Key Premera Plan Changes for 2017

- Except for emergency care, there will be no out-of-network benefits – you need to use doctors in your Premera network to receive benefits.
- In King, Pierce and Snohomish counties, Premera only offers their PersonalCare plans which give you a choice of doctors within one of five systems: UW Medicine, Virginia Mason, Northwest Physicians Network, MultiCare Health System, or EvergreenHealth Medical Center.
- Premera will no longer be available in the following 12 counties: Mason, San Juan, Skagit, Lewis, Skamania, Klickitat, Yakima, Kittitas, Chelan, Douglas, Lincoln, Ferry, Stevens and Pend Oreille. See the [state map with links to plan summaries by county on Premera's website](#).
- Rate increases (average around 20%)
